A native Houstonian attended the University of Texas at Austin and is a graduate of the University of Houston, Greg Goodman has been around thoroughbred racing all of his life and has been actively involved for 14 years in the industry principally as an owner and breeder. His father, the late Harold V. Goodman owned Brazos T Farm in Brookshire, Texas and stood the stallion Marzotti. He served an important role in the passage of pari-mutuel betting in Texas.

Mr. Goodman and his wife Becky own Mt. Brilliant Farm in Lexington, Kentucky where he has 25 broodmares. Goodman owns Justenuffheart (Broad Bush) dam of 2006 champion filly Dreaming of Anna, Snow Forest (Woodman) dam of stallion Snow Ridge and Pavrotti, and Tee Kay (Gold Meridian) dam of 2002 and 2003 Horse of the Year and two year old and older horse Champion in Japan, Symboli Kris S (Kris S). He sold the top priced colt at Keeneland last year out of the mare Taegu and was ranked number one by average of horses sold last September.

Goodman is involved in every aspect of the business, stallions, broodmares, sales and racing and is a member of the TOBA Board of Trustees. He was also a member of the Texas Thoroughbred Association and is involved with the Thoroughbred Research Institute.

He is also actively involved in investments, finance, real estate development, construction and manufacturing.
