Ogden Mills (Dinny) Phipps has been actively involved in the Thoroughbred industry for more than 40 years. He has served as chairman of The Jockey Club since 1983 and is a board member of Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation, Equibase Company and several subsidiaries of The Jockey Club.

He is a current director of the Breeders' Cup Board and previously served on the organization's Finance & Investment Committee. He also served as chairman of the New York Racing Association from 1976 until 1983.

Phipps is a director of Bessemer Securities Corp. and Bessemer Trust.

Phipps has owned and raced the champions Inside Information, Rhythm, Storm Flag Flying and Smuggler as well as the 2005 Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Pleasant Home.

In 1978, Phipps was honored with an Eclipse Award of Merit and the New York Turf Writers' Association award as "The Man Who Did the Most for Racing." In 2002, he received the Industry Service Award from the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association.
