TURF TRAINING: ONLY FOR HORSES ENTERED TO RACE ON NOVEMBER 3 AND 4 (BCWC & UNDERCARD)

All international turf horses must be assembled at quarter chute and be ready to enter the turf course at 7:15 (to jog on the turf course on the outer rail (**NO BREEZES**), all horses must be off the track no later than 7:30. Horses must have a Turf Slip from the Racing Secretary or from the IRB. Turf horses will exit the turf course through the gap at the wire and proceed through the tunnel gap into the paddock where they will receive their jog up exams. **NO EXIT THROUGH THE QUARTER CHUTE.**

9:45 ANNOUNCEMENT-MAIN TRACK IS CLOSING

All domestic turf horses must be assembled at quarter chute and be ready to enter the turf course at 9:45 (to jog on the turf course on the outer rail (**NO BREEZES**), all horses must be off the track no later than 10:10. Horses must have a Turf Slip from the Racing Secretary or from the IRB. Turf horses will exit the turf course through the gap at the wire and proceed through the tunnel gap into the paddock where they will receive their jog up exams. **NO EXIT THROUGH THE QUARTER CHUTE**.

Hours are extended until 10:00 to enter the paddock from the main track, those horses exit the paddock through the horse path back to the barn area. Riders may school in the paddock and in the saddling stall area during this time.

Paddock Schooling Hours after Main Track is closed are 10:30-11:30 accessible only through Barn area and no riders on horses in the saddling stall area, only lead shank only.

MANDATORY JOG UP EXAM – BCWC RUNNERS & UNDERCARD

Breeders' Cup Important Information for Participating BCWC & Undercard Horsemen:

In the interest of horse and rider safety and upon listening to the concerns expressed by local horsemen, Breeders' Cup and 1/ST are revising the originally planned veterinary jog up exam path.

Beginning Friday October 27, all horses that will be running on Friday, November 3 and Saturday, November 4 will need to pass mandatory jog up exams in the quarter mile chute **prior to exiting** the racetrack each day.

All BCWC and undercard horses must stay to the outside rail when exiting the track via the quarter chute and will be directed when to begin jogging which will be marked in purple on the rail with a starting and stopping point. We will have the safety steward David Nuesch and other staff informing the riders as they approach the path. This is just a pass-through exam, you will not be asked to stop or turn, you just exit the racetrack by jogging through the quarter chute in the designated path. After jogging for the veterinarians, horses may then continue off the racetrack.

Horses that go to the paddock to school after training through the tunnel gap will have their exit jogging exam there in the tunnel.

All BCWC and undercard runners must wear their Breeders' Cup provided saddle towel when on the racetrack.

If a BCWC or undercard trainer prefers that their horse train on the <u>training track</u>, the trainer **MUST FIRST** make an appointment 24 hours in advance with Tiffany Leggett to do the jogging exam with rider up before they access the training track. Please call Tiffany at (210) 823-6853 or via email <u>tiffany.leggett@1st.com</u> and be aware that there are limited windows.

Veterinarians will be at the jogging lane on the main track beginning at 5:00 am for any BCWC or undercard horse.

Main Track Training Hours; 5:00am - 9:45 am

Main Track Renovation Breaks are at: 6:00, 7:15 and 8:30am

The first 10 minutes after each renovation break will be high speed workouts only

Turf Training: (All horses must train between the cones on the outer portion of the turf)

International horses that have received permission to jog on the Turf will assemble and be ready to go at 7:15am and after completing their training need to exit either through the designated jogging lane in the quarter chute or may exit through the tunnel gap where they will be asked to jog.

Domestic horses that have received permission to jog on the Turf will assemble and be ready to go at 9:45am and after completing their training need to exit either through the designated jogging lane in the quarter chute or may exit through the tunnel gap where they will be asked to jog.

Training Track Hours: 4:45am – 10:00 with renovation breaks at 6:45 and 8:00 am
